Title 1 at Schoolcraft

Title 1 is a federally funded program designed to address the academic needs of students and to assist them in meeting the state's high standards, particularly in the areas of reading, writing, and math. Schoolcraft Learning Community has a school wide Title 1 Program. We receive funds based upon the number of students who are eligible for free lunch. All students are eligible, as needed, to receive supplemental instruction and support in academic areas of need. This assistance may occur inside the regular classroom or sometimes by working individually or in a small group outside of the classroom.

Parents Also Benefit From Title 1

I support you! Title I schools offer training to support parents in the education of their child. Areas of training may include:

- Getting to know EL/SLC and what all those crazy acronyms really mean
- Setting expectations and goals for your child
- Technology
- Effective communication with the school/your child's teacher
- Parent advocacy

You should have high expectations when your child attends SLC. As a parent of an SLC crew member you will:

- Have opportunities to volunteer in your child's classroom and at SLC events
- Have timely information about Title 1 programs
- Receive a description and explanation of Expeditionary Learning and the curriculum we use, if requested
- Receive a monthly newsletter with "parent power" tips and information
- Have opportunities for regular meetings to formulate suggestions and to participate, as appropriate, in decisions relating to the education of your child, if requested
